Jimmie has been closely involved with the RSCDS, serving on the Executive Council, Management Board, and numerous committees. He was the founding editor of Scottish Country Dancer and has contributed many articles to it. He teaches English in one of Edinburgh's state schools, researches the early history of Scottish country dancing, and is a keen sailor, restorer of wooden boats, and a lover of opera!
